Our runs are designed for two dogs and clients can choose single or shared runs. It is compulsory for a number of breeds to go into a single run, unless they are boarding with a family member. These include;

The reason for this is purely for the animal's welfare. For your pet's safety and the other pets here we always keep single run breeds on their own. At Hanrob we do understand that many of the above breeds are very well socialised with other dogs and regularly attend the local dog parks, beaches etc., however in a confined space they may not be happy to share a kennel with another dog. It is just not worth the risk to your dog or the other dog in case they fight.

Having a single run means that they have their run to themselves and are charged the single run rate. They can also enjoy regular playtime one on one with a playtime attendant, which they will love.
